How many students are served by SC's Public Charter Schools?

Over 35,000 students across the state are currently served by 77 public charter schools. There are 6 new schools in the final stages of approval to open in August of 2019 and over 15 planning groups actively developing charters to meet the future educational needs of South Carolina's students.

What does the Alliance do?
